

Autonomous Transportation and Connected Roads (ATCR) Announces First Round of Seed Grant Funding



The <u>Autonomous Transportation and Connected Roads</u> (ATCR) Seed Grant Program awarded three research projects in its first round of competitive funding. The ATCR is a collaboration between Georgia Tech and external sponsors, including <u>Delta</u> focused on stimulating research into the possible uses and infrastructure needs of autonomous vehicles (AV). Research teams will use <u>Curiosity Lab at Peachtree Corners</u>, which includes a 1.5-mile AV test track as their living lab.
